## The Power of Family Time

In a world where we spend most of our time surrounded by people who don't share our faith, the time we spend with our church family becomes incredibly precious. Consider this: if you work a typical job, you spend about 40 hours a week around people who believe and act differently than you do. But how much time do we actually spend with our brothers and sisters in Christ? For many, it's only about four hours per week. That's roughly one-tenth of the time we spend in secular environments compared to time with our church family.

We might think we're strong enough to handle life's challenges alone. For a while, we might even succeed. But eventually, the weight of the world will overwhelm us. This is where family time with fellow believers becomes essential. God has blessed us with our church family as one of His greatest gifts, yet it's often one of the most underutilized blessings in our lives.

What does church family time provide? First, it offers comfort. Life brings struggles to everyone, and as Christians, we must ensure that none of our family members ever feel alone. Galatians 6:2 tells us to "bear one another's burdens and so fulfill the law of Christ."

Second, it helps us fight temptation together. Satan prowls like a roaring lion, looking for someone to devour (1 Peter 5:8). Like any predator, he waits for the straggler who becomes isolated. But Ecclesiastes 4:12 reminds us that "a threefold cord is not quickly broken." When we're together with God, we become unbreakable.

Third, it equips us through study. Proverbs 27:17 tells us that "iron sharpens iron." When we study together, we discover different perspectives on Scripture and realize we're not alone in our spiritual journey.

Finally, it builds us up. First Peter 4:10 reminds us that we each have received gifts to serve one another. Sometimes the most encouraging thing we can do is simply be present. Just as a human body struggles when one part is missing, the body of Christ feels the absence when family members aren't there.

This week, prioritize your church family. Don't just attend services—actively engage. Look for opportunities to comfort someone struggling, study with a fellow believer, or simply encourage someone by your presence. Remember that being unstoppable as a church requires us to be together, supporting and strengthening each other. We cannot achieve God's purposes as isolated individuals.

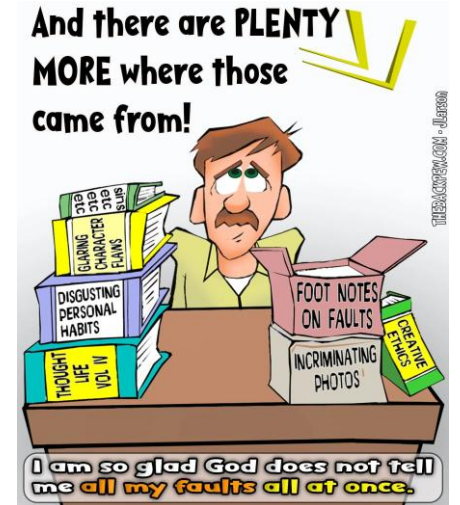
