Experiencing God's Future Kingdom Today

Have you ever wondered what it would be like to experience something from the future right now? That sense of experiencing what's coming in the present moment captures something profound about Pentecost—and what continues to happen in our world today.

Pentecost represents the moment when God's future kingdom broke into our present reality. The "what will be" began breaking into the "what is," allowing God's people to experience His eternal kingdom right now. We're not passive spectators waiting for heaven—we're active participants in His kingdom work today.

The Old Testament prophets painted a picture of God's ultimate plan: gathering His scattered people from across the earth and including people from every nation. Isaiah declared God would "gather the dispersed of Judah from the four corners of the earth" (Isaiah 11:12). Ezekiel promised: "I will take you from the nations and gather you from all the countries" (Ezekiel 36:24).

When we read Acts 2, we see this great gathering beginning. Jerusalem was filled with "devout men from every nation under heaven." The apostles began speaking in languages they had never learned, and people from different nations heard God's mighty works proclaimed in their own tongues. This was the reversal of Babel's curse and the beginning of God's great gathering.

Some might ask, "Why don't we see these miraculous languages today?" But something even more amazing is happening right now. Across the globe, God's mighty works are being proclaimed in every language—Mandarin, Hindi, Spanish, Ukrainian, French, Arabic, and countless others. What began at Pentecost continues today.

Throughout Scripture, we see two consistent responses when God does something new: some marvel and ask, "What does this mean?" Others mock and explain it away. It's easy to become cynical and think God only did amazing things in biblical times. But salvation and participation belong to those who marvel.

This week, choose to marvel rather than mock at what God is doing. You're not just waiting for a future kingdom—you're presently participating in it. Every time you share God's love or proclaim His mighty works, you're part of the global family that began gathering at Pentecost.
