## **Someone Is Coming to You**

Life is hard. The Bible makes no promises otherwise. Job reminds us that "man born of woman is of few days and full of trouble" (Job 14:1). Paul tells us we "groan being burdened" in these earthly bodies (2 Corinthians 5:4). There's no avoiding the reality that following Jesus doesn't exempt us from hardship—it actually guarantees we'll face trials.

But here's a truth worth remembering: When life pushes you down and won't let you get up, when you've done all you know to do, when you have nowhere else to go—it doesn't matter, because someone is coming to you.

In Matthew 14:22-27, we find the disciples in a boat, three to four miles from land—halfway across the Sea of Galilee. They were too far to go back to where they'd been, yet still so far from where they were going. The boat was "beaten by the waves," or more literally, "tormented by the waves." They were encapsulated by despair in the darkest watch of the night.

Haven't we all been in that boat? One phone call changes everything. One diagnosis stops your world. One loss leaves you wishing you could go back to the way things were, knowing you can't, while the shore of peace seems impossibly distant.

But watch what Jesus does. He was on the mountain praying, spending time with His Father about matters weighing heavily on His heart. Yet when He saw His disciples in despair, He left talking to God to go to the trouble of the apostles. He came to them when they needed Him most. Even more remarkably, He came in ways they never imagined—walking on the water. When He got into the boat, Mark tells us the wind ceased. John tells us the boat was immediately where it was going. Invite Jesus into the boat of your life's struggles, let Him take over, and get ready for peace—a peace that passes understanding.

We have a High Priest who can sympathize with us, who is "tempted in all points like as we are yet without sin" (Hebrews 4:15). He dispatches angels into the unseen realm of providence to serve those who inherit salvation. He doesn't just answer prayer—He moves in ways we can't see or explain.

Jesus set aside His own grief over John the Baptist's death to care for the crowds. He sees your need. He knows your pain. And the promise remains: "I will never leave you nor forsake you" (Hebrews 13:5).

Someone is coming to you. No—He's already here.
