God First in an Upside-Down World

Recently, I had the privilege of attending a week of Church Camp at Valley View Camp in Greenbrier, Tennessee. It was an uplifting and encouraging experience that came at just the right time. This particular week of camp is called Camp Henotes, a name derived from the Greek word for “unity.”

The theme of the week was “The Upside Down.” This theme was based on the Beatitudes found in Matthew 5:3–12 and centered on the idea that the world often operates in ways that are opposite of God’s design and purpose. Throughout the week, we participated in Bible classes, youth-led devotionals, and worship services that explored each verse of this powerful passage.

One lesson that especially stood out to me was Matthew 5:8: “Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God.” This verse contains an important truth for every follower of Christ. Having a pure heart does not mean being perfect. Rather, it means making God the central focus of our lives. God knows we will never be flawless, but He does expect us to place Him above everything else.

The world often sends a very different message. We are constantly surrounded by distractions that compete for our attention and devotion. Sports, hobbies, careers, and countless other pursuits can easily take priority over our relationship with God. When our hearts become filled with these things, there is little room left for Him.

God does not desire only a portion of our hearts—He deserves all of them. When we put Him first, everything else finds its proper place. A life centered on God allows us to live according to His will and grow closer to Him.

The promise found in the second half of Matthew 5:8 should encourage us all: “for they shall see God.” This is the ultimate hope of every Christian and the desire of our Creator for all people. God wants us to be with Him, and a heart devoted to Him leads us toward that eternal goal. As we seek to follow His commands and keep Him at the center of our lives, we can look forward to the day when we will see Him face to face.

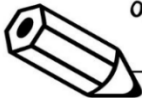
