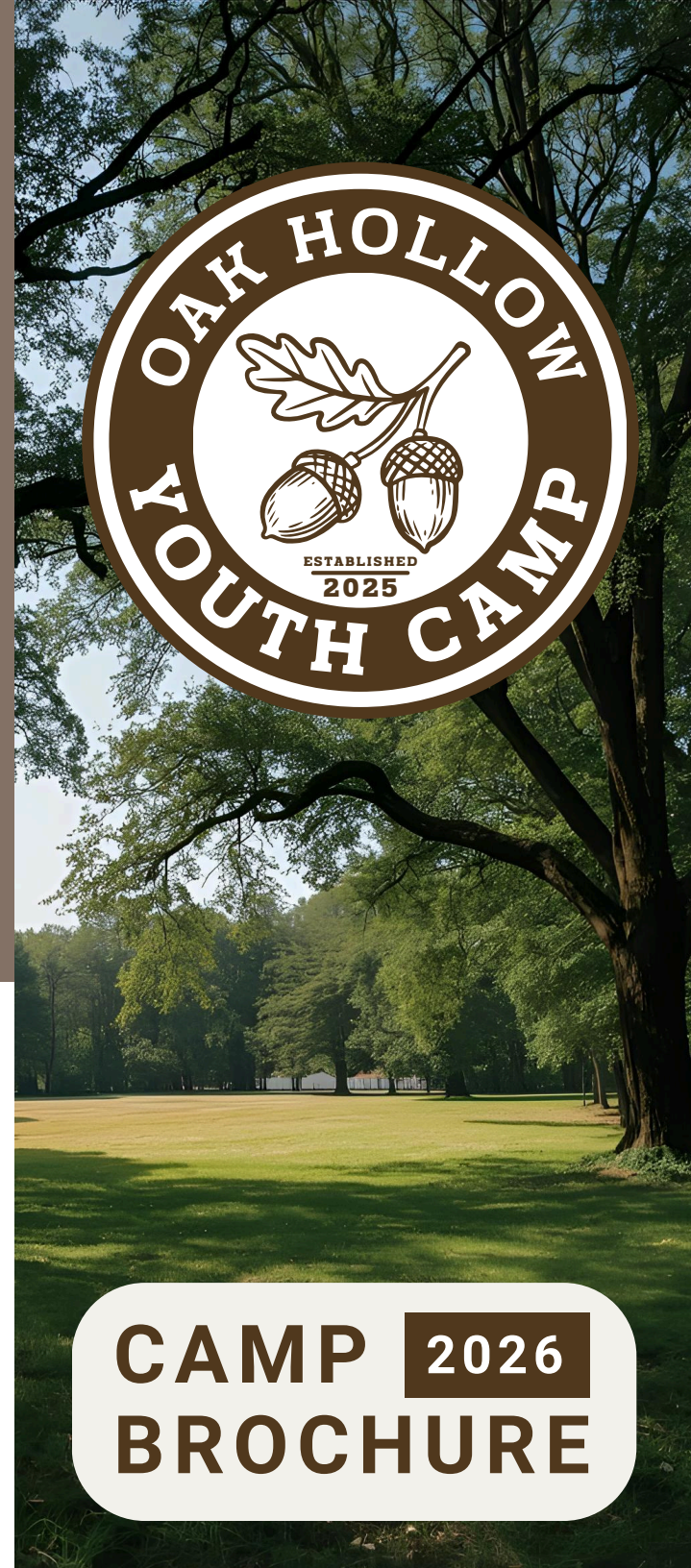

Ages:

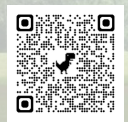
Completed 2nd Grade - 12th Grade

Dress Code

1. Shorts should be no shorter than 3" above the knee. This applies to both male and female campers.
2. No tank tops, tight fitting, or midriff shirts are permitted.
3. All clothing should be appropriate for a Christian camp.
4. We request that parents write their child's name or initials on everything to prevent lost items.



Camp Rules
