Straightening the Crooked

This week we're getting back to our study of Titus and the Successful Church. Paul, when he was writing to Titus, told him, "The reason I left you in Crete was that you might **straighten out** what was left unfinished..." (Titus 1:5). This phrase in the original Greek is a medical one—epidi orthoo—the word used for setting a broken bone so it heals straight and strong. The church in Crete was broken and hurting so Titus was sent to help things properly align so as healing comes they would be what the Lord wanted them to be. Appointing elders in every town was how Titus would accomplish his mission.

⁵ *This is why I left you in Crete, so that you might put what remained into order, and appoint elders in every town as I directed you—⁶ if anyone is above reproach, the husband of one wife, and his children are believers and not open to the charge of debauchery or insubordination. ⁷ For an overseer, as God's steward, must be above reproach. He must not be arrogant or quick-tempered or a drunkard or violent or greedy for gain, ⁸ but hospitable, a lover of good, self-controlled, upright, holy, and disciplined. ⁹ He must hold firm to the trustworthy word as taught, so that he may be able to give instruction in sound doctrine and also to rebuke those who contradict it."*

Titus 1:5-9

The Shepherds of a congregation are so important. But why are they so important? Let's study God's word this Sunday about Elders leading a congregation and how we can be a successful church when we align with God's Holy Word.
