God's Saving Grace Made Manifest

This Sunday morning we will continue our series on God's grace. We talk and sing about God's amazing grace, but grace is more than a word we read in scripture or sing about in song. God's grace is something we experience in the Gospel of Jesus Christ. It's something we live out every day. Jesus our Lord and Savior is the grace of God made manifest. John says Jesus came "full of grace and truth," and from Him we receive "grace upon grace." Paul reminds us that although all have sinned, we are "justified freely by His grace" through the cross of Christ.

*¹⁴ And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, **full of grace and truth.** ¹⁵ (John bore witness about him, and cried out, "This was he of whom I said, He who comes after me ranks before me, because he was before me.") ¹⁶ For from his fullness we have all received, **grace upon grace.** ¹⁷ For the law was given through Moses; grace and truth came through Jesus Christ.*
John 1:14-17

The more we know and understand the gift of God in giving His Son Jesus to save us, the more we will understand the nature of God's grace. Grace is God's initiative, God's costly gift, and God's transforming power. In Christ, grace isn't merely a word that comes across our lips, it's a way of life.

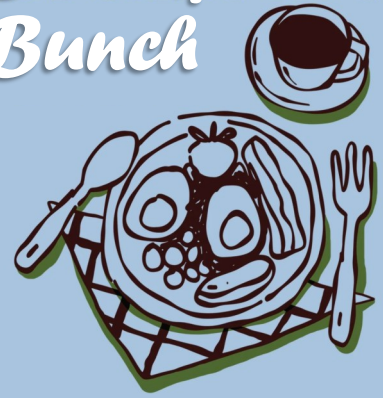
